l've never run Warlords I in Dosbox but I've run Warlords 2 many times without any problems.

l always run full screen (Alt-enter).
I always speed up the CPU because the default speed is too slow for animations/movement/AI etc. Typically I speed up to 15000 range. If you go too fast the sound starts to echo (F12 to speed up, F11 to slow down).

How are you starting Dosbox? There are parameters to pass in order to emulate a soundblaster16 (which Warlords 2 supports). Warlords I only supported PC speaker so you should not expect much sound on that game.
