Haven't heard of anyone with that problem before and plenty have installed on Win 10.

A couple of questions:

- 1) Are you installed a USA version of the CD (may be issues with non-USA/English)
- 2) Where are you installing it (directory wise)? I would not recommend installing in the default place (c:program files) because War4 needs to write locally and that's frowned on in Win 7 and later. I'd recommend installing in 'My Documents' or a similar user owned folder.

I had copied them to my desktop so I could find them to copy, so maybe the search found those version idk. So I run the warlord4 exe with admin and I get the window permission popup and let it run.

Nothing happens and task manager does not show warlords.

I rename the exe and copy in the one from patch 105b and it get fsound errors.

Anyone have any magic response that will let me play this again? Funny I have warlords dlr working.

Wish UBISOFT would sell some sort of wrapper to make this work and run at desktop res. I would pay a few dollars and I would suspect many others would. A nice job for an intern.
