As I understand it:
If you are running 64 bit MS Windows you can't run 16 bit applications (except by using a virtual machin

If you are running 64 bit MS Windows you can't run 16 bit applications (except by using a virtual machine which itself is running 32 bit MS Windows). Warlords3 is a 32 bit application but the installer is a 16 bit application. So you can't run the W3 installer but you can run the game once it's installed. So options include:

- 1. Install W3 on a 32 bit MS Windows box and just copy the entire game directory over to the 64 bit box.
- 2. Install W3 using a virtual machine and then run the game without the virtual machine. (This requires that the VM uses the same file system as the underlying operating system.)
- 3. Install and run W3 using a virtual machine. (You're stuck with this if the VM does not uses the same file system as the underlying OS.)

Some versions of Windows7 include a VM. If you don't have a VM already, you can get various free ones (e.g., www.virtualbox.org/). The free ones don't come with 32 bit MS Windows so you will need
