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Since the GOG version of DLR has some timing errors in its music tracks, I've created some high-quality ogg rips off the original CDs.

This link contains both the Darklords Rising and Reign of Heroes soundtracks, so you can interchange them freely. The RoH tracks have a lot of long silences at the end of each track on the CD, and I've used a tool to shorten those.

I've also included SteamWarlord's RoH reskin.
