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CaptainRed,

Something is definitely messed up. The individual scenarios in the campaigns are not downloaded separately. They are contained in 1 file the zip archive file that ends as .w3c

Try starting entirely again.

1) Go to the campaign folder and delete the ones you already think you unpacked (Staff, LOTR, Huge). Then do the same in the scenario folder (I don't know all the names. But if you sort by date the ones you recently added should be easy to spot and delete. Or just rename the Scenario folder to Scenario1, create a new empty Scenario folder for testing).

2) Then place the .w3c file for each campaign in the folder:

C:\Program Files\Red Orb Entertainment\Warlords III - Darklords Rising

3) Unpack the campaign using the campaign editor war3cmpn

After that check the scenario folder and see if scenarios were added.

For example the LOTR campaign LORDRING.w3c file has only 4 episodes (its a short one). So you should see 4 scenarios added to your scenario folder called moriav11, hdhdhdhd, lsengrda, pellenor.

P.S. One other thing. I don't have long path names (names longer than 8 characters/with spaces) on my machine. DLR is old enough that long path names didn't exist. It could be that you are having problems due to long path names. You might want to temporarily copy your entire Warlords folder to someplace like C:\Warlord3 and try unpacking like that. Then copy it back where you want it.
